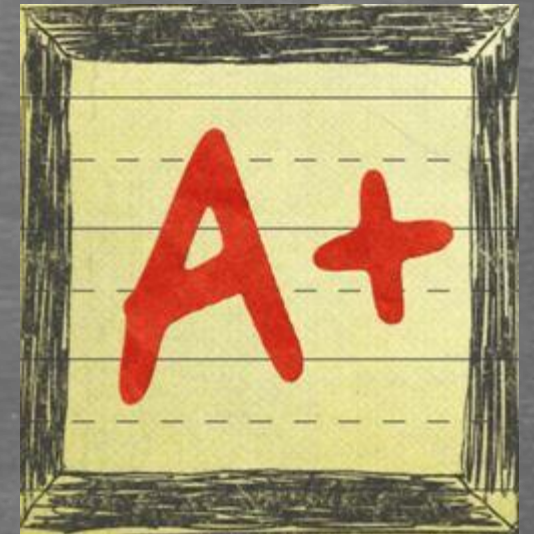

Drop-off, pick-up and parking rules

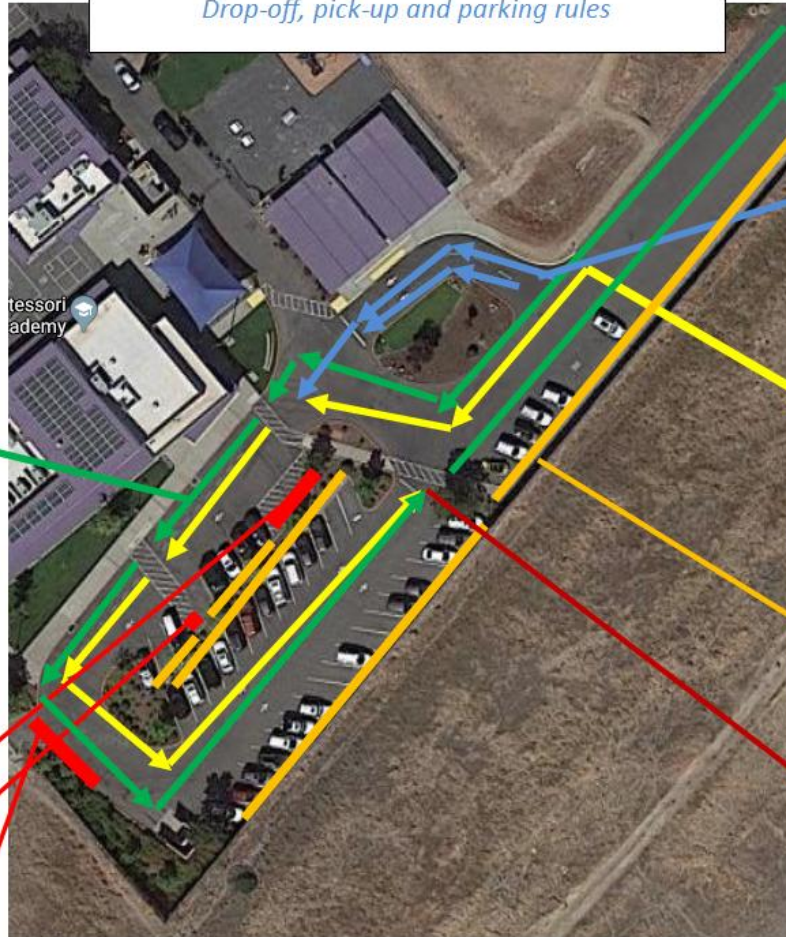


Drop-off/Pick-up is ultimately a student safety issue – please be patient, courteous and cautious for our students, staff and families.

Drop-off/Pick-up Lane

- Please pull forward as cars leave in front of you;
- Please do not leave your car unattended; and
- Please follow the green path out the school driveway

PLEASE NO PARKING in RED areas during Drop-off/Pick-up



Preschool Only Drop-off/Pick-up Lanes – please NO LEFT TURNS out of Preschool Drop-off/ pick-up area

Drive through to park lane STARTS HERE – NOT at the street. Please pull forward and park in designated parking spot

Designated Parking Spots are marked with ORANGE

Please alternate and merge into the single exit lane out the drive way
